In 1964, the Demarchi family bought Château Haut-Queyran, formerly named Domaine de Haut Brion until 1989. The vineyard is composed of 15 Ha of North-Médoc vines, to the limits of St. Estèphe, on a clay-limestone soil. Since 2001, the estate is managed by Demarchi descendant, Laurent and Patricia, that carry on the familial tradition: strict respect of the terroir.
