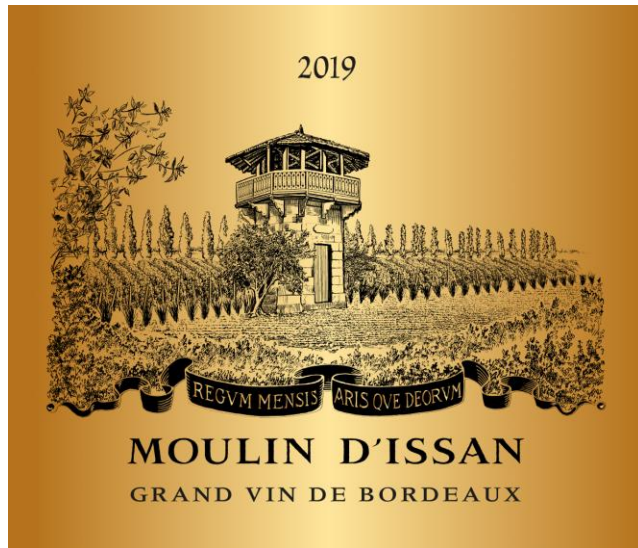

NEW PACKAGING since 2019

The Moulin d'Issan label is changing with the 2019 vintage.

Henceforth, our new label represents a water well facing its vineyard which belongs to the property since the historical 1855 Classification.

Birth of Moulin d'Issan in 1986

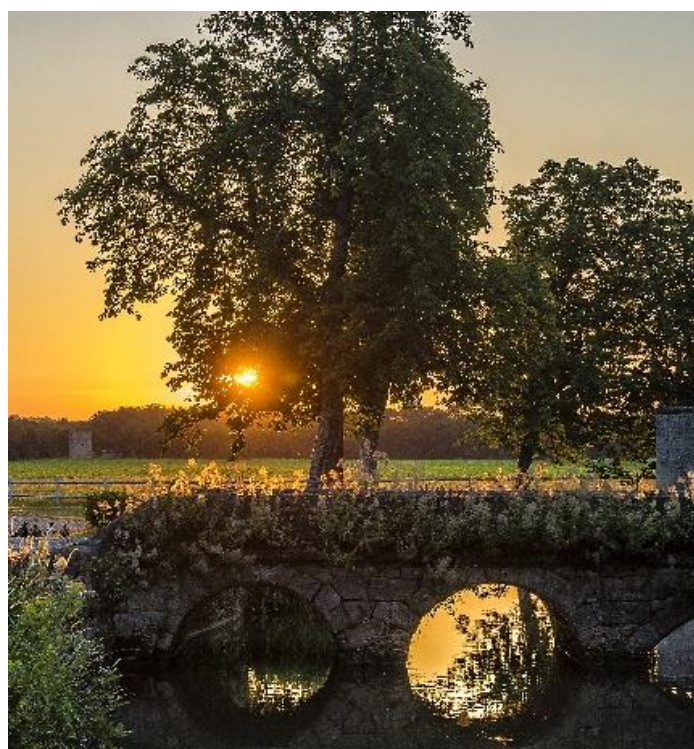
The brand was founded in 1986 by Lionel Cruse, 2nd generation of the Cruse's Family at Château d'Issan. The ruins of the old 17th century windmill, which gave its name to this wine, are still in the middle of the estate.

Moulin d'Issan single vineyard

The two first parcels dedicated to Moulin d'Issan were planted in 1985. The Moulin d'Issan vines represent 10 hectares of single vineyard. Facing the Château d'Issan, this terroir is a real link between our biodiversity area and our Margaux vineyard.

Moulin d'Issan terroir

Close to the Gironde Estuary, the soil is mainly composed of clay and limestone and therefore particularly suited to the Merlot grape variety, which generally contributes to 90% of the blend.



Moulin d'Issan 2021

Moulin d'Issan 2021 expresses the richness, the suppleness and the fruit character of its origins in a perfect balanced way. Charming in its youth, it has a beautiful ageing potential. Hand-picked, this wine aged in barrels which 25% are new oak for 14 months.

The blend is from 90% of Merlot and 10% of Cabernet Sauvignon.
