The plots of La Fleur Corbin are located in the township of Montagne Saint-Emilion, satellite appellation of Saint-Emilion. The vineyard belongs to the Cru Classé of Saint-Emilion: Grand Corbin Despagne. The DESPAGNE family, owner of the estate, is present in Saint-Emilion since the 16th century. It is Louis DESPAGNE that bought the first plots in the township of Grand Corbin in 1812. Today it is the 7th generation represented by François DESPAGNE, who manages the estate.
