The plots of La Fleur Corbin are located in the township of Montagne Saint-Emilion, satellite appellation of Saint-Emilion. The vineyard belongs to the Cru Classé of Saint-Emilion: Grand Corbin Despagne. The DESPAGNE family, owner of the estate, is present in Saint-Emilion since the 16<sup>th</sup> century. It is Louis DESPAGNE that bought the first plots in the township of Grand Corbin in 1812. Today it is the 7<sup>th</sup> generation represented by François DESPAGNE, who manages the estate.
