Bordeaux Tradition

Red Light color typical from 2014 in this part of Right Bank with carmen color glint. The nose need to be oxygenated a little. Then, it shows a nice character, red fruit and subtle berries. In mouth, nice expression of the merlot, long to the palate and fresh. It needs to find its pick in 2017/2018 announcing a great freshness. The wine is well balanced thanks to a discrete structure. Tension and freshness conclude the tasting. Once again, it is the elegance that is clearly researched.
