AOC Graves de Vayres white

Château Goudichaud (Appellation Graves de Vayres) is located on the banks of Dordogne river, very close to the famous appellations Saint Emilion, Pomerol and Fronsac. Belonging to the Glotin's Family, the wine estate is part of the best properties in the appellation both for the quality of the wines and the high production capacity. Château Goudichaud, bearing the name of the estate, is the reference wine and shows a great delicacy.

Our Goudichaud has a great aromatic complexity with a really lovely colour. The elegant nose has a blend of floral and slightly exotic fruits. A complex wine with an explosion of aromas on the palate. Elegant with a great persistence. A good balancewine, very pleasant to drink as an apéritif, with seafood and fish, or just sip on its own.
