

Domaine de la Grâce d'Ornon 2011

Pessac-Léognan



Domaine de la Grace D'Ornon is the second wine of château Pontac Montplaisir, AOC Pessac-Léognan, estate that is owned by the MAUFRAS family since 1920. Bought by Auguste MAUFRAS at that date, it now belongs to Alain MAUFRAS. The will of this family: performance and quality thanks to their knowhow and knowledge of the vineyard.

The estate is located on the township of Villenave d'Ornon. The vines are next to the ones of the famous Grand Cru Classé châteaux Carbonnieux and Couhins. Today the vineyard's surface is 16 hectares: 13 for the red wine and 3 for the white wine.

Bordeaux Tradition

The color is deep, the nose intense, the aromas are mainly black fruit, vanilla and pepper both in the mouth and to the nose. This wine is perfect for ageing.
