

Château Haut Rozier 2016

Francs Côtes de Bordeaux

Château Haut Rozier is located in the township of Tayac near Lussac and has been bought by Romain Pascal. On a single piece, the terroir is ideally facing South/South-West. What distinguishes this propriety from its neighbors is the combination of modernity and tradition in the winemaking process. The vinification is lead by the owner, Romain Pascal, and his team. The equipment in the chai is modern: stainless tanks and concrete tanks.

Bordeaux Tradition's mind

With a deep purple colour, the nose of this vintage is jammy, with very marked aromas of ripe red fruits. In the mouth the wine has a fleshy attack and is very think. The tannins are mellow and rich. The final mouth is long with a toasted sensation.
