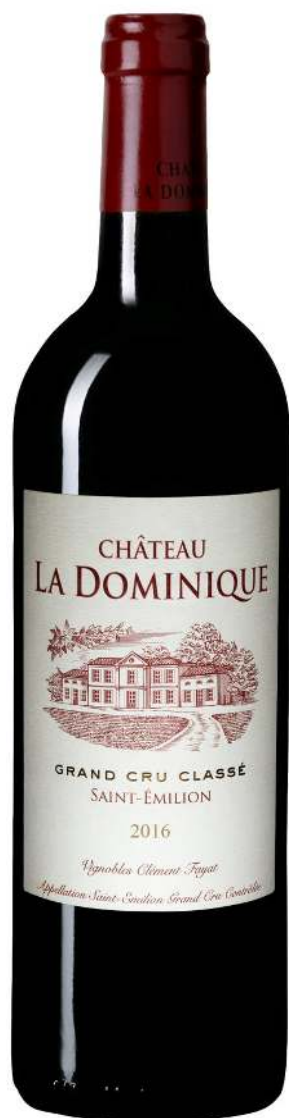


CHATEAU LA DOMINIQUE, SAINT-EMILION

Château La Dominique is well located in the North-West of Saint-Emilion, neighbor of Château Cheval Blanc and Château Figeac, on the side of Pomerol appellation. It's the estate of Clément Fayat since 1969. Nowadays, Château La Dominique skilfully harmonizes modernity and tradition with an high-tech cellar designed by Jean Nouvel.
