Premières Côtes de Blaye

Château La Motte is an old castle of the Middle Age. Marie-Caroline de Bourbon, duchess of Berry, lived here until she was jailed by King Louis-Philippe. The vineyard is closed to regions of Pauillac and Médoc : it is the Gironde estuary only that is separated it (a tunnel under the estuary may exists between Blaye and Lamarque fortress). Xavier Valet is now the actual owner, following the path of his father Michel. He is assisted by the oenologist Mathieu Huguet, who is also advising Château Tour de By.

Bordeaux Tradition's mind

The gravel soil of Château La Motte produce very qualitative wines, vintage after vintage, thanks to the hydrometric and temperature regularity. The colour is bright garnet, the nose reveals fruits aromas and the mouth is fleshy with berry notes. Sourness is pleasant and the whole is balanced, greedy and round. This wine is fine to drink now or for the 3 to 5 next years.
