

Château La Motte 2019

Blaye – Côtes de Bordeaux

Château La Motte is an old fortress dating back to the Middle Ages. Marie-Caroline de Bourbon, Duchess of Berry, stayed there before being imprisoned by order of King Louis-Philippe, in the citadel of Blaye. The vineyard is close to the Pauillac and Médoc regions, as they are only separated by the Garonne River. Xavier Valet is the current owner of the Château, succeeding to his father. He is assisted by Mathieu Huguet, consultant oenologist of several properties, including Château La Tour de By. For several years, Xavier Valet has been turning towards a more reasoned viticulture, in accordance with his principles of environmental preservation.

Tasting Notes

This bright ruby wine offers delicious notes of wild berries and liquorice. The texture on the palate is full and delicate, ending with hints of rhubarb jam.
