Château La Raze is owned by Vanesse Cruse and René-Philippe Duboscq, also owners of Château Laujac.

This domain is located in the middle of Médoc terroir. Soils are mixed with gravels and clay-limestone. The 9Ha La Raze vineyard is composed of mixed clay and small stones. The property is equipped with a very modern cellar and thermo-regulated inox vats that leads to perfect fermentation. The wines stay in oak barrels for many years.
