

Moulin d'Issan 2010

Bordeaux Supérieur



Moulin d'Issan is the third wine of the renowned Château Moulin d'Issan 3rd classified growth of the classification of 1855. The estate is owned by the CRUSE family and managed by Emmanuel CRUSE. Even if the vines are located in the Margaux appellation they cannot benefit of it as they are too close to the river.

Moulin d'Issan is aged in the same cellars than Château d' Issan and is handled with the same care. The final wine is structured like most wines arising of the Medoc region. Freshness and fruit is brought by the Merlot present at a 100% in the wine.

Bordeaux Tradition

The 2010 vintage is mellow and supple. The dominant aromas in the nose are black fruits such as ripe black currant. To the mouth the wine is fruity and offers the same aromas as the nose. Oak and delicacy then take place. The wine is balanced. The 2010 is in the contumacy of the 2009 one of the best vintages of the estate. This wine is very good quality/price ratio.

Why buy this wine?

- The wine receives the same care as the renowned château d'Issan
- The fermentations are traditional and the wine is aged in the same cellars as the first label within 25% of new barrels
- As the years go by, production is decreasing in profit of quality
- The 2010 is like the 2009: one of the best vintages at Moulin d'Issan.
