Home of iconic estates of the Left Bank (Chasse Spleen, Poujeaux, Maucaillou), Moulis en Médoc abounds in terrific values. Looking after them, we've met Bernard Lartigue, proud owner of the famous Cru Bourgeois Ch. Mayne Lalande in the next door AOC Listrac. And that's how we discover his hidden jewel Ch. Myon de l'Enclos. Cru Bourgeois too, Ch. Myon de L'Enclos is a garden at the Médoc scale (5ha). But, as Neal Martin said while reviewing the 2014 vintage (rated among the best Moulis Cru Bourgeois): "This is a Moulis that is worth checking out". And so we did. Seduced by the classicism, by the nobility of the wine, by the work made to balance immediate pleasure and typical Left Bank style, we took over the whole production of this 2015 vintage ... in Wooden Cases!!!
