A 70/30 blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc from 30-year-old vines. This wine ages 18 months in 45% new French oak from five different coopers, and a small portion ages in Italian fabricated terra cotta jars. Seductive young cherry aromas, as well as those of blueberries and moist earth. This is a wispy wonder—ethereal, precise, silky and providing a creamy mid palate (as well as finish) that includes crisp and dark blackberries, blueberries, cherries as well as sultanas. Excellent, invisible integration of fine acidity, fruit and tannins.

A blend of 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Franc, all from certified organic vineyards; there is also Cabernet Sauvignon planted here, but it is not in the grand vin. It was picked at a yield of 36 hl/ha, starting September 8th for Merlot, and September 29th for the Cabernets. Dark and glossy in the glass, with a black cherry-violet hue, the nose allows the perfume of the Cabernet Franc to shine through, with violets and lavender to the fore, behind which there sit summer fruits with a very fine sense of purity, along with notes of sage, mint and pencil shavings. This also comes across on the palate, which has a suggestion of volume, the blackcurrant and black bean fruit finely delineated, but also precision, with a cleanly drawn frame of rich grippy tannins and fresh acidity. Pure and pointed, with mint chocolate, cedar and toasted almonds, this shows grip and persistence in the finish. This is a really strong showing for this estate, which is clearly on an upwards trend. Impressive. The alcohol is 14%.

NEAL MARTIN

The 2020 Beauregard was picked from September 8 at 37hl/ha (winemaker Vincent Priou told me that having been organic for almost a decade, the vineyard is very stable in terms of yield). Matured in 45% new oak, it has a very pure and refined bouquet, one of the best that I have found on a Beauregard at this stage. The palate is medium-bodied with ripe tannins, a slightly grainy texture and a spicy undercurrent. Very cohesive and silky-smooth on the finish. This just might be the best Beauregard made to date. Bravo!

Deep garnet in color, the wine quickly shows off its floral aromatics along with spice, licorice and black plums. Soft and silky, polished, fresh and elegant, the chocolate centric finish with all its ripe, dark red pit fruits tastes as good as it feels. Beauregard has really been upping their game the last couple of years

Full bottle 1,349 g. Cask sample taken 6 April. 70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Franc, certified organic. Fermented in concrete tronconic vats. Aged in 45% new oak. Deepest purple-crimson with purple rim. Surprisingly subtle but deep aroma of pure black fruit with only a gentle hint of the leafiness I expect from the Cab Franc. On the palate, concentrated black fruit, slightly savoury/rocky in that darkness, chewy but not astringent tannins. Lovely freshness on the finish to balance the whole, and a gentle fruit sweetness on the finish. (JH)

Soft, rich, black-cherry and oak-vanilla nose, very appealing; rich, supple, fresh, and very finely tannic; sweet, gently caressing wine, very long to taste, complex, vibrant with an acidity so well-integrated for the year; black-fruit ripe, yet fresh and creamy, linear and fleshy at once, deep and satisfying, and with lovely length. The 30% Cabernet Franc class and finesse is very clear, and this is beautiful wine, the very image of fine Pomerol at a (relatively) affordable price. 2026–40+

Spice, coffee, black and blue fruits and touches of redcurrant leaf. Sappy and powerful, not as generous as many in Pomerol, but there is always a good level of Cabernet Franc that gives this a slightly austere structure when young - will widen and soften over the next few years, and it stands out for its kick of minerality. Tasted twice, and there is some notable oak, but excellent quality. Ageing for 16 months in barrel. Finished everything by 22 September, their final yields were 37hl/ha (they have 1/3 of the vineyard at 9,000v/ha). Certified organic for 10 years.

Deep purple-black colored, the 2020 Beauregard gives up pronounced notes of baked black plums, blackberry pie and black cherry preserves, plus hints of tar, aniseed, tilled loam and chargrill, with a touch of fried herbs. The medium to full-bodied palate offers chewy tannins and soft acidity to support the black berry and savory layers, finishing on a stewed tea note. The tannins should become a lot more polished after barrel aging, but based on this tasting, I've been conservative with my score. 2025-2040
