

Château Rocbonnière 2016



Château Rocbonnière is located at the extreme west of the Côtes de Castillon, on the border of the Saint-Emilion Grand Cru appellation. Its vineyard is a few steps away from Château de Pressac. This estate belongs to the Bourrigaud family since 1999. Implanted on clay-limestone soils, the 4 hectares of vineyard are composed of Merlot (58%), Cabernet Franc (12%) and Cabenet Sauvignon (30%) with an average age of 25 years. This blend of soils and grape varieties produces aromatic wines with a deep colour, typical of the appellation.

Bordeaux Tradition's mind

A very aromatic wine. The rich, dense color comes from the Merlot, dominant in the blend. The palate, full and complex, allows the wine to be savored at an early age.
