- QUALITY OF CHÂTEAU RAUZAN-SÉGLA 2025:

- Once again this year, Rauzan-Ségla has produced a truly great wine, in the same lineage as the 2015, 2016, and 2020 vintages, as reflected by the scores awarded by the specialized press.
- The quality of the wine reflects the work carried out over the past 30 years under the stewardship of CHANEL.
- The experience gained over the last ten years enables Nicolas Audebert and his teams to produce the 2025 vintage of Château Rauzan-Ségla, whose precise and vertical signature reveals the full identity of the wine and allows the infinite richness of its aromatic palette to shine through.
- The parcels destined for Rauzan-Ségla are 90% located on Terrace 4.
- The 2025 yield is 29 hl/ha, similar to previous years. The consistency between quality and volume has allowed us to achieve exceptional balance. Once again this year, uncompromising blending preserves a balance of 50% Grand Vin and 50% Second Vin.

- COMMERCIAL STRATEGY:

- In order to preserve the brand’s value and sustainably support our partners as well as the en primeur system, the estate commits not to release the 2025 vintage to the market before 2032.
