SAINT-EMILION - GRAND CRU CLASSÉ

Vintage 2020 .

Ideally located northwest of Saint-Emilion, on the edge of the Pomerol appellation, the 29 hectares of Château La Dominique, owned by the Fayat family since 1969, are distinguished by a remarkable terroir, whose excellent plots border the most famous vineyards of the region - Cheval Blanc, Figeac, La Conseillante, L'Evangile.

PRODUCTION AREA	25 ha
SOIL	Clayey gravel, clayey-limestone and sands on clay
AGE OF THE VINES	30 years
DENSITY	7 500 plants/ha
GROWING METHOD	Traditional, cover crops every two rows, according to the vigour of the vine
PRUNING	Simple and double Guyot
HARVEST	Entirely manual from September 10th to 23rd for the Merlot and October 23rd and 30th for the Cabernets
CELLAR	Stainless steel truncated cone vats of 73 hl
AGEING	14 months : <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 50% in new oak- 40% of a wine- 10% in amphoras, vegetal polymer egg and in wine globe
AVERAGE YIELD	38 hl/ha
BLEND	85% Merlot - 12% Cabernet franc 3% Cabernet sauvignon
ALCOHOL CONTENT / pH	14,5% vol. - 3,8 pH

Taste : Nice balance between fruits and freshness, tight and harmonious tannins. a nice length in the mouth

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
