

Rosé de Chevalier 2011

Bordeaux - rosé



The rosé de Chevalier belongs to the Domaine de Chevalier, famous classified growth of Pessac-Léognan. During the harvest, just after the Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon designed for the red wine of Domaine de Chevalier have been put into the vats, part of the wine is pressed and put into barrels so they can be aged 4 to 5 months just before the bottling. The process is called the « saignée »,

In this way the rosé de Chevalier 2011 comes from the best.

Bordeaux Tradition

The color is vive rosé and bright. This wine offers red fruit aromas such as cherry and red berry, the whole is fresh.

In the mouth, the wine has a nice fruit acidity that gives a fresh sensation. The final is fruity and complex.

This quality rosé from a classified growth has the best quality/price ratio.
