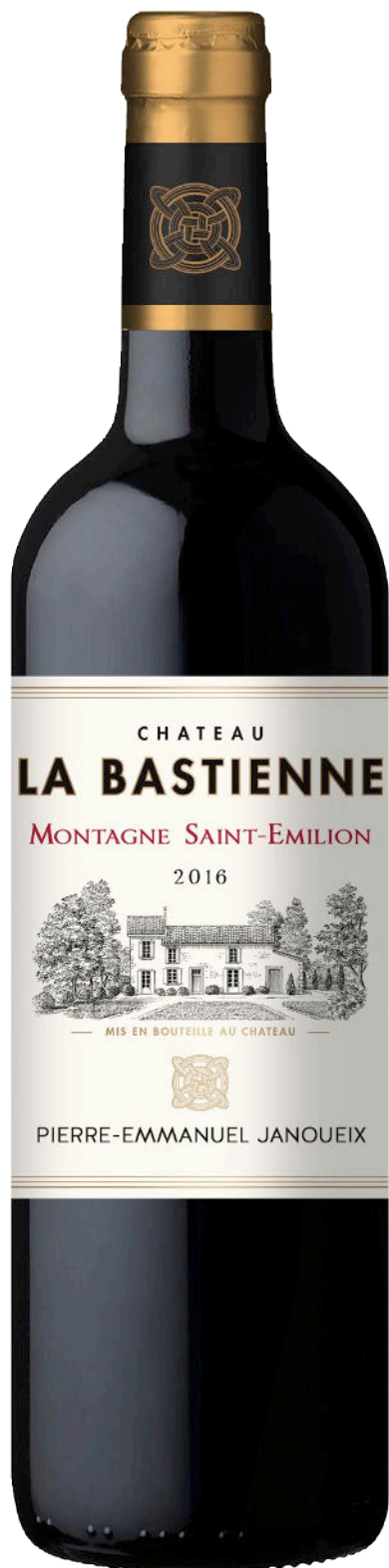




CHATEAU LA BASTIENNE (Montagne Saint-Emilion AOC)



Quantity: 85 000 bottles

Grape variety: 100 % Merlot

Surface: 12.5 ha

Plant density: 6600 plants per hectare

Soil and subsoil type: Clay-limestone

Average age of vines: 50 years old

Exposure: Southwestern slope of Lalande-de-Pomerol plateau.

Viticulture: Integrated viticulture, High Environmental Value certification.

Yield: 55 hl/ha maximum.

Harvest: Handpicking and sorting.

Vinification: Classic winemaking during one month in thermo-regulated concrete vats.

Maturing: 12 months in oak barrels.

Ageing: 15 to 20 years according to the vintages.

Tasting note: Beautiful ruby red colour. Expressive of black fruits and sweets spices. Velvet smooth tannin structure followed by a very long aftertaste in mouth.

Wine pairing: Duck breast skewers, potatoes and foie gras, braised leg of lamb, guinea fowl and ceps.

Service: 17 °C. Open 5 years after bottling.

Particularity: Introduced in great restaurants and prestigious tables like the President of National Assembly's table.
