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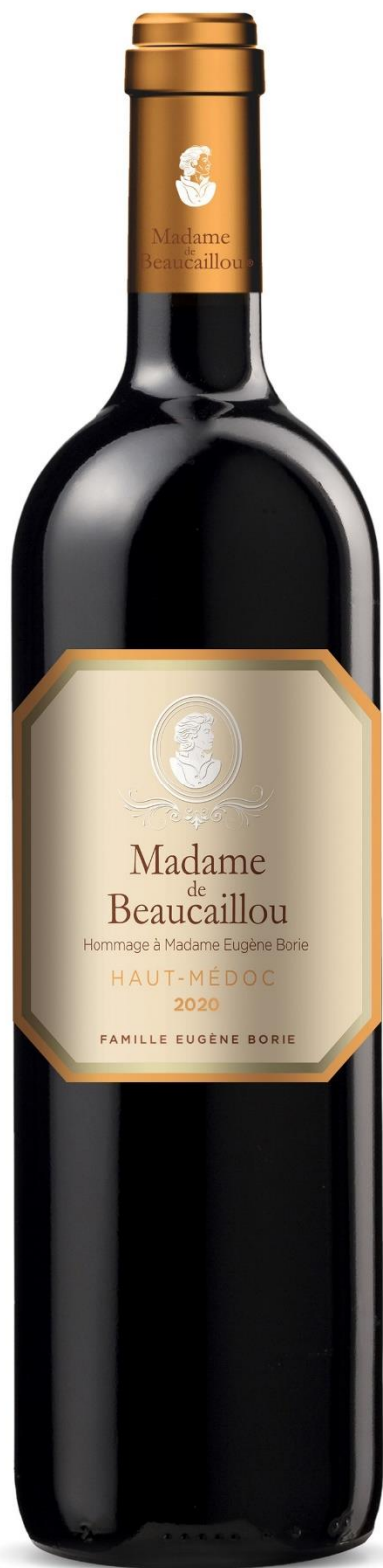

MADAME DE BEUCAILLOU HAUT-MÉDOC 2020

Lovely balance of berry and chocolate with some walnut undertones. It's medium-bodied with a round, pretty finish. Fresh and tight at the end. Nice softness. 66% merlot, 24% cabernet sauvignon and 10% petite verdot.

Ch. Ducru-Beaucaillou Madame de Beaucaillou 2020 91-92

Cette nouvelle cuvée du château Ducru-Beaucaillou célèbre deuxième cru classé à Saint-Julien, est en appellation Haut-Médoc et elle est issue d'une refonte de la gamme avec intégration des vignes à Listrac (ex Fourcas-Borie) et quelques autres. Avec ses arômes de violette, le vin est souple et charmant, très rond, suave, avec une petite dureté en finale pour le moment.

Caractéristiques techniques. Cépages : 66 merlot, 24 cabernet-sauvignon, 10 petit-verdot. Il titre 13,5° avec un IPT de 89 et un pH de 3,68. Élevage avec 20 % de fût neuf.

Madame de Beaucaillou (Haut-Médoc) 2020: This is the relatively new *cuvée* from Château Ducru-Beaucaillou, utilising vineyards in Cussac-Fort-Médoc and Listrac-Médoc (as well as 1 hectare in Moulis-en-Médoc), the Listrac vines having previously been the source of fruit for Ducluzeau. There is a significant selection made, with a large volume sold off in bulk, which helps explain the good quality here. The blend is 66% Merlot, 24% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Petit Verdot. Dark and glossy, with a violet-black rim, the nose here suggests currants, perfumed juniper, toast, black bean and slate. There follows an attractively sinewy style on the palate, filled with pithy grip, carrying blackcurrant fruits, black bean, toast and liquorice, wrapped up in a fine-grained structure supported by a rich bed of toasted tannins. This has lovely grip and substance to it, a savoury balance, and a deliciously dark perfume. It's long too. This is worth checking out. The alcohol is 13.5%. 90-92/100 🍷

Reviewed by  Lisa Perrotti-Brown	Made from the vineyards that Ducru-Beaucaillou owns in the Haut-Medoc, the 2020 Madame de Beaucaillou is a blend of 66% Merlot, 24% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Petit Verdot. The alcohol is 13.5% and the pH is 3.68. It is set to age for 12 months in French oak barrels, 20% new. Deep garnet-purple colored, it strolls out of the glass with ready-for-business notes of warm black plums, blackberry pie and kirsch, plus hints of menthol, graphite and wild thyme. The medium-bodied palate is wonderfully expressive, featuring soft tannins and acidity, finishing with a spicy kick.
