PICHON-BELLEVUE RED WINE



Classification:

Graves de Vayres

Grape varieties:

80 % Merlot 15 % Cabernet Franc 5 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Soil:

Gravely soil

Wine growing:

Low yields, hand tending, careful selection 40 hl/ha

Wine making:

De-stalked grapes – alcoholic fermentation at high temperature with daily rack and return – long maceration – malolactic fermentation

Tasting:

Draped in a garnet color, the wine first reveals itself olfactively with scents of cooked fruit, prune and fresh leather, to offer a warm sensation of spices and sweet almond in the mouth, wrapped in silky tannins.
